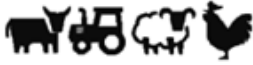

SUBMISSION ENTRY FORM FORMAT

Entry forms for both Phases 1 and 2 must be completed electronically and emailed to: secretary@fermanaghcountyschoolshow.com. The entry form for Phase 1 and Phase 2 can be downloaded from the website: www.fermanaghcountyschoolshow.com - it is an EXCEL spreadsheet with a sheet for phase 1 and a sheet for phase 2, see bottom tabs when you open document. Please download complete save and return by email by 14th March 2018 (Phase 1) and 13th June 2018 (Phase 2). Please contact the secretary on 028 6632 2509 if you have any problems.

You will notice Phase 1 only requires numbers of pupils entering each class in your school we do not require names for this phase, when judging is complete at Easter we will type up names of winners, however phase 2 requires names of children and a Group needs to be entered in correct age and give names not 'GROUP'

By completing the form electronically not only are we able to reduce paper wastage but we can further eliminate issues that arise deciphering handwriting and 'typos' which occur when faced with transcribing 3000+ names and details.

Entry fees will remain at 30p/entry for those electronically submitted however it will rise to £1/entry for any submitted on paper. Please post on entry fees in normal manner to show office.

Please detail subject line as '**School Entries**' to ensure that it is not missed in a busy show office environment and please save the form as an excel workbook, **NOT PDF**.

SCHOOLS SECTION RULES

ONLY PRIZE-WINNING AND OTHER OUTSTANDING EXHIBITS WILL BE DISPLAYED

N.B. ONLY ONE ENTRY PERMITTED PER PUPIL PER CLASS IN CLASSES 55- 108

1. **THERE IS A LIMIT OF 10 ENTRIES PER SCHOOL IN CLASSES 1-54**
2. Entry fee must be posted or left in show office. ENTRY FEE IN ALL CLASSES 30p (electronic submission) or £1 (paper submission).
3. A competitor can only submit one entry per class.
4. Ages will be reckoned as at 1st July 2018.
5. **All exhibits must be the unaided work of the exhibitor and must be certified as such by the teacher**
6. All entries must be made through the school which the pupil attends.
7. All or any prize winners in this section may be called upon at the discretion of the Committee to repeat their work in the Exhibition & Auction Centre or at another location after the show is over.
8. **EXHIBITS IN CLASSES 1– 54 MUST BE BROUGHT to The Show Office, at the Exhibition & Auction Centre, Old Tempo Road, Enniskillen BT74 4BA **between 14th– 21st March.** Judging will take place in the following weeks.**
9. **ALL EXHIBITS IN CLASSES 55–108 MUST BE BROUGHT to the Show Exhibition Hall at the Exhibition & Auction Centre, Tempo Road, Enniskillen BT74 4BA to Ground Floor on Monday 6th evening between 7pm and 9pm and only between 9am & 10.30am on 7th August**
10. **Classes 1-54** each exhibit must have the name, age of the exhibitor and school written clearly on the REVERSE side of the exhibit. **In Classes 31-35** the Judge has requested that the Original Artist and Title of the painting be displayed on the front of the painting with the exhibitors name, age and the school on reverse of exhibit. **Classes 55-108** each exhibit must have the name, age, school year and school written clearly in ink and placed inside or attached in an inconspicuous position on the article. Reasonable care will be taken of all articles but the Committee will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to any exhibit before, during or after the Show.
11. All persons enter the Exhibition Hall at the discretion of the Stewards in charge.
12. No person will be permitted to interfere with, or crowd the Judge when adjudicating. Exhibitors doing so will forfeit claims for prizes.

13. The decision of the judges as to the merits of exhibits shall be final. Objections to a competitor on the grounds that he or she is not qualified to enter in a certain class will be considered if lodged in writing with the Secretary, together with a fee of £10.00 before 3 pm on the day of the Show. This fee will be returned if a valid objection is sustained otherwise it will be forfeited to Show funds.

14. Should any matter arise not provided for in the purview of these Rules & Regulations, such matters shall be referred to the Committee, whose decision shall be final & binding, no appeal in any case being permitted.

15. The Show will close at FOUR o'clock, when all persons must leave the Exhibition Hall. Exhibitors and Assistants will then be re-admitted at the discretion of the Stewards on duty. No exhibit will be allowed off the stands before 4pm when school representatives collect the exhibits.

16. The Exhibition Hall will be cleared out at 5pm on Show Day and no responsibility will be accepted for any exhibits left therein after that time.

17. Any prize money may, at the discretion of the Judges, be withheld or modified according to merit.

18. **Classes 1-54 : EXHIBITS MUST HAVE CHILD'S NAME, AGE, SCHOOL NAME IN FULL SECURELY ATTACHED BY THE TEACHER BEFORE THEY ARE BROUGHT TO THE SHOW OFFICE between 14TH & 21ST March. Entries for these classes close 14th March. LABELS WILL NOT BE POSTED TO SCHOOLS FOR THESE EXHIBITS AS ONLY WINNING EXHIBITS WILL BE NUMBERED BY SECRETARY, POST JUDGING.**

19. **Classes 55 -108 CRAFT - ON RECEIPT OF PHASE 2 ENTRY FORMS (CLOSING DATE) 13th June 2018, THE SECRETARY WILL POST OUT NUMBERS TO EACH SCHOOL BEFORE THE END OF TERM—exhibit numbers cannot be posted out until ALL school entries are in! ALL CRAFTWORK & NEEDLEWORK EXHIBITS MUST BE BROUGHT TO THE EXHIBITION HALL AT E&A CENTRE ON 6th AUGUST OR 7th AUGUST 2018.**

20. NO EXHIBITS TO BE LEFT IN THE SHOW OFFICE AT ANYTIME.

21. The Show does not accept responsibility for any misspelt names and the responsibility remains with the family and the school to ensure names are spelt correctly for engraving trophies.
